Summary:

Treasurer's Report:

- Balance sheet is in the agenda. \$45,000 in Vanguard has been transferred.
Motion passed for Trisha, CLSA Accountant, to update and re-invest CD as convenient.

Executive Director- Kimi Shigetani:

- The CLSA executive committee met in July to discuss the 2026 conference and the 60th anniversary celebration aka The Gala, of CLSA

Legislative Committee:

- Mike Belote: the legislation is on final approach- like a plane touching down. We should have just had (Sept 12) and recess either way after that the governor has a short time to sign or veto appx 1200-1500 bills.
- CA budget is still the big unknown
- 2-'Trailer Bills' were added re: CEQA reform
- The Big Picture: Big budget problem, CEQA reform, fires we had in So. Cal this year.
- AB 1341- a fight going on right in July to enforce against unlicensed practice.
- BPELGS and Contractors Boards support the bill; contractor's association is strongly against it. When AB 1341 goes to the full Senate please call your Senator and urge them to vote yes.
- Discuss a proposal to have CLSA sponsor a bill disallowing counties from contracting out their county surveyor position. **The board voted that Director's take it back to the Chapters to get feedback and then we will discuss it in November.**

Monument Preservation Committee:

Dave Woolley presented the following motion. Michael M. was not in attendance.

"I move that the CLSA Board recommend the withdrawal of the Q4-2024 Monument Preservation Committee guidance on BPC § 8771.6 and direct that any future version be developed in close alignment with the statutory framework, peer-reviewed prior to publication, and designed to provide practical, legally consistent support for the professional community" **Motion Passed**

WFPS:

- In Arizona an LS cannot report another LS unless he or she has been harmed by that person. Utah Boundary Line Agreements are no longer allowed

BPELGS:

- The number of active PLS has increased by 7% since 2014.
- Renewal increases in mid-2026.
